WHO: Open to all female golfers who reside in the state of Kansas and have a GHIN number.

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 - Includes Monday Qualifying

Round (Championship Flight players only), Tuesday and Wednesday play, Tuesday lunch, and prizes. \$6.00 for practice balls. Winners advancing to the finals on Thursday will not pay for the final round.

FORMAT: Tuesday - Thursday - Match play flighted by handicap in flights of eight (8). Monday's qualifying round is 18 holes of stroke play.

The Match Play Champion will be the winner of the Championship Flight. Entrants with a course handicap from the Red tees of 10 or less must play in the qualifying round for a position in the Championship Flight. Entrants with a course handicap higher than 10 may try to qualify for the Championship Flight as well. Those who do not qualify for the Championship Flight will be seeded in another flight based on their handicap.

SCHEDULE:

Monday: 1:00 p.m. Qualifying round for Championship Flight. Entrants with a course handicap of 10 or less from the Red tees must play in the qualifying round for a position in the Championship Flight. Tex Consolver is a public course so golfers may call the pro shop for a practice round prior to the tournament, depending on availability, with regular course fees paid directly to the Pro Shop.

<u>Tuesday</u>: 8:00 a.m. Golfers will begin match play from Tee #1. All flights will play from the Red tees. Box lunch will be served immediately following play.

<u>Wednesday</u> 8:00 a.m. All flights will again begin on Hole #1. Winners from Tuesday advance to the Winner's Bracket. Those not winning on Tuesday move to the Consolation Bracket.

<u>Thursday</u>: 8:00 a.m. All flights tee off on Hole #1 for the final matches with winners from Wednesday's play. Awards presentation immediately following play.
