**Eligibility**

Open to female amateur golfers. You must have a handicap index active through GHIN.

**Team**

One Pro or 'Acting Pro' and three ladies from the same club. Each club is allowed to enter 2 teams up to April 21st. After that date additional teams will be allowed if space is available. Final deadline is April 28. ***Field is limited to 26 teams.***

**Entries & Fees**

The entry fee is \$62.00 per player/\$186 per team. The entry fee includes green fee, cart, range balls, prizes, and food following play. There is no entry fee for pros or 'acting' pros.

**Format**

The team's lowest gross score (1 player) plus the team's lowest net score (1 player) are added together to equal the team's score for the hole. The gross and net score must be from two separate players. Amateurs-90% of your handicap will be used. Pros will play from the **BLUE** tees, amateurs from the **RED** tees, acting pros from the **WHITE** tees.

**Schedule**

Shotgun start at 1:00 p.m. Registration is from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. Hamburgers, chips, a drink, and cookies will be served while waiting for scorecards to be processed.

**Flights and Prizes**

The April 28th revision handicap will be used. One prize will be awarded for every five teams entered. Amateurs will receive cash prizes.

***Pros will have a separate tournament, contact Colin O'Bryan (316-992-8503) to enter.***

**Rules of Golf, Competition is Final**

Play will be governed by The Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA. USGA Method of Matching Scorecards will be used to break all ties. Questions will be settled by the on-site Rules Committee, whose decision will be final. The competition is final when awards have been presented.

**Dress Code**

Proper golf attire is required. Jeans, halter tops, tank tops, and athletic t-shirts are not permitted. Shoes with metal spikes are not permitted.
